### CHRIST CHILD SCHOLARSHIP

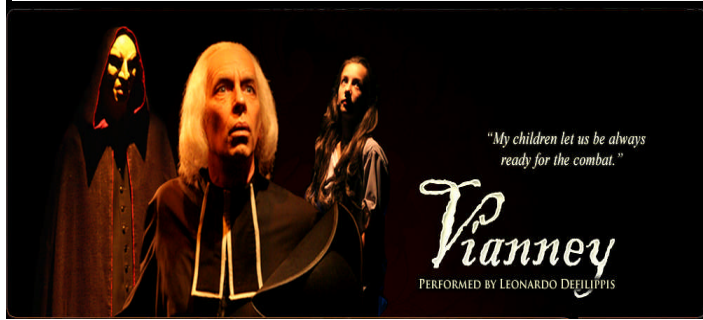
